In 2005 I purchased film rolls from the Montana Historical society of their collection of the Mineral Argus newspaper. The photos were fairly clear and readable to the extent one could actually glean some insight to the daily lives of the pioneers, miners, and shopkeepers of the period.

Though many images were unreadable and in their current form of film rolls, I then had the microfiche rolls transferred to digital images. The collection takes up several DVD discs that make for interesting reading on long Montana Winter nights. Some of the highlights to those readings are listed below.


